Minutes Spruce Pine Town Council Monday, August 22, 2022

CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

James Acuff moved to approve the agenda with the addition of a tap application request and a solicitation permit request to the action agenda. Jackie Rensink seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Darlene and Crystal updated the Council on the auditors' opinion that the Town should not be in the business of loaning money through the revolving loan program. Rocky Buchanan moved to discontinue the revolving loan program. James Acuff seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. The three current outstanding loans will continue to be paid by the borrowers. Crystal noted that the current balance in the UDAG funds-repaid account is \$916,538.31, and that money can be placed in a term portfolio, with the annual interest budgeted for council-determined projects.

James Acuff moved to grant a solicitation permit to the Spruce Pine Lions Club to fundraise at the intersection of 19E and 226S on October 15, 2022, with a rain date of October 29, 2022. Rocky Buchanan seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Larry McKinney moved to approve a water tap at outside rates with no annexation to Carolyn Atkins at 822 Ridge Road. Jackie Rensink seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
