Minutes Spruce Pine Town Council February 12, 2024 5:30 PM

A meeting of the Town Council was held on February 12, 2024. Present were Mayor Phillip Hise and Council Members Rocky Buchanan, Larry McKinney, Wayne Peight and Jackie Rensink. Staff in attendance included Darlene Butler, Crystal Young, Anthony Hensley, Spencer Bost, Michael Wood, Kasey Cook, and Brooke Peterson. Others attended, including, Chad Donnahoo, Chase Thomas, and Donnie Staton.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Phillip Hise called the regular meeting to order at 5:30 PM. Rocky Buchanan gave the invocation. Larry McKinney led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Larry McKinney moved to approve the agenda. Jackie Rensink seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Larry McKinney moved to approve the minutes of the January 22, 2024 Town Council Meeting. Rocky Buchanan seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

ACTION AGENDA

- ✓ Phillip Hise opened discussion on a request from Eric Nutter for providing and maintaining water service outside city limits on Kates Lane with a 2-inch line. The Council unanimously decided in order for the town to accept the water line the following guidelines must be in place:
 - o NCDEQ Public Water Supply guidelines would be followed.
 - o The line would be designed and permitted by a qualified engineer.
 - o The installation would be carried out by a licensed and qualified contractor.
 - o As-built drawings would be provided to the Town of Spruce Pine.
 - The line would need to be a minimum of 6-inches in diameter, for future additional customers and fire protection.
 - o The Town of Spruce Pine would bear none of the cost of the project, from planning through construction.
- ✓ Larry McKinney moved to appoint Roger Burleson as a member of the Zoning Board of Adjustment. Rocky Buchanan seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
- ✓ Darlene Butler presented a proposed ORC Bonus/Increase Policy. Larry McKinney moved to approve the policy. Wayne Peight seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. The policy is attached to these minutes.
- ✓ Larry McKinney recused himself from the meeting. The council discussed awarding the Vehicle Cleaning Contract. Darlene Butler stated there are 17 total vehicles to be cleaned and the bid was very well publicized from January 11th to the 31st. She noted that four bids were received, with the bid from Larry McKinney being by far the lowest. Consensus of the Council was to go with Larry McKinney as low bidder. To that purpose, Darlene summarized aloud the Resolution Authorizing the Town to enter into a service contract with Larry McKinney for vehicle cleaning. Wayne Peight moved to adopt the resolution. Jackie Rensink seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. Said resolution is incorporated by reference, and attached to these minutes. Larry McKinney then returned to the meeting.

DEPARTMENT UPDATES

Parks and Rec

- Parks and Rec Director Michael Wood presented his February report for Parks and Rec, which is incorporated by reference and attached to these minutes.
- He noted the vandalism that is occurring at Brad Ragan. His crew is getting that cleaned up. He would like to propose installing cameras in the upcoming year.
- Phillip Hise discussed the options with the old bathrooms at Riverside Park, either being completely remodeled or removed. The council asked for staff to seek costs to demolish the old restrooms.
- Michael Wood noted about opening up for the summer and hosting a grand opening around Memorial Day.

Police Department

- Police Chief Kasey Cook updated the Council on the police department for the month of January, presenting a log with a total of 302 calls logged through Mitchell County Communications. Said log is incorporated by reference and attached to these minutes.
- He said his new officers were working out well, with Officer Sale working on his own and Officer Woody still working with supervisor.
- Officers are being present at the parks and all town streets more often.
- The department is still down two cars, but will hopefully pick those up in a few weeks.
- Chief Cook discussed the new License Plate Reader equipment that the county and surrounding counties have installed and getting that in this upcoming budget year. This equipment will be very beneficial to the department.
- The new K-9 will be here soon and Officer Mace will be training. The department will have a K-9 for both shifts.
- The evidence building is working out great. The department appreciates it.

Finance

- Finance Officer Crystal Young gave the Council an update on the financials for the period ending January 31, 2024. Said report is incorporated by reference and attached to these minutes.
- She noted that the budget meeting will be coming up on March 25th, 2024 and proposed going to a different location for the meeting. A few local restaurants were mentioned and she will be contacting those to see the best option. She will send an email confirming the location. Chad Donnahoo noted that the public can still attend for the meeting portion.
- By the end of the year, typically 97.5% of taxes are paid. Unpaid taxes will be advertised in April.
- Crystal updated the Council on the BRIC grant application, which was submitted February 5th. A response will be given by August.

Water and Sewer

- Project Manager Donnie Staton with Veolia gave his report for the month of January. Said report is incorporated by reference and attached to these minutes.
- He noted that the roof at the water plant will need to be replaced soon. He is waiting on a quote for a total repair and gutters.
- The septic hauler dumping station has been moved to a manhole near the waste plant and that has resolved several issues. The pumps have not had to be pulled since December.

Public Works

- Public Works Director Anthony Hensley presented a Work Order Summary Report for his department. Said report is incorporated by reference and attached to these minutes.
- He stated his appreciation to the Council for the new truck.
- He has filled the vacant position in Public Works.
- Anthony met with the local 811 group. He now has contacts, therefore making communication easier.
- He attended a meeting with Darlene Butler and HCCOG concerning the storm water project and mapping storm drains.
- He attended classes in Cornelius at the NC Rural Water Training Facility for Collections 1 and 2. The tests for that will be held in March.
- He noted there is currently a contractor for the 3 Peaks Project that is installing a new sewer line that goes directly into our pump station at that location and he has observed that process.

Main Street

- Main Street Director Spencer Bost presented his monthly report for Main Street. Said report is incorporated by reference and attached to these minutes.
- The Main Street committees are developing work plans for 2024.

- He is working on the 2024 Schedule of Events. There are currently only 3 vacant weekends from May to November.
- Work on the Fire on the Mountain Festival is ongoing. Altec is now a sponsor.
- He has hired a Main Street assistant. Katie Elkins will be vital in expanding media efforts.
- The placement at Riverside Park of the kayak mosaic created by artist Emma Cadman is now complete.
- He met with Hilloween staff about a possible Halloween parade.
- Rebranding Spruce Pine Main Street has begun working toward more cohesive signage and logo.
- Phillip Hise spoke about his concern for the town's responsibility and role in the Christmas lighting/decorations. Spencer Bost responded with enhancing communication between all groups. Main Street will be managing all financing. The current decorations from the town will remain the same. Spencer Bost discussed a committee, and would love for this council to be represented, as well.

PUBLIC COMMENT

❖ Walton Shepherd, owner of L&L Furniture, wanted to extend his appreciation to the Council for the upcoming 3rd Annual Downtown Worship event on May 29th, 2024 from 5:30-8:30. L&L Furniture is fully funding this event. The Special Use Application has been completed and submitted. Brian Burgess from Clayton King Ministries will be speaking. There will be a variety of food/snack options. There will also be several children's events before the actual worship begins. He also discussed blocking upper street and his communication with DOT.

MANAGER'S UPDATE

- Town Manager Darlene Butler noted her concern for conflicting dates between the Toe River Arts Studio and the Alien Festival. TRA has opted to change their event to May 31-June2, 2024.
- The SEARCH invitation from Dr. Larson is this Thursday.
- ➤ She attended a meeting on February 5th at Asheville Regional Airport discussing expansion.
- She attended the ABC Board meeting which discussed allocations given to the Spruce Pine Police Department and the Mitchell High School rehab program.
- She noted the Mitchell Chamber is facing financial challenges, and that one concern is for the Gem Festival.
- > She also reminded the Council of upcoming meetings to consider attending.
- She met with Withers Ravenel for Streetscape and beautification.
- > She also met with HCCOG for digital mapping of storm water system. RFQ's were readvertised for inventory assessment and capital improvements, which are due February 29th.
- Ethics training online is coming up and it is required for newly elected officials. She will possibly look at attending online at upcoming meeting and projecting for everyone at one time.

At yesterday's Town Council meeting, The Town Council considered your request for the Town of Spruce Pine to accept ownership of approximately 1575 feet of 2-inch water line proposed to serve the area of Kate's Lane in the Ledger community.

It was the consensus of the Town Council that in order to accept the water line the following criteria would apply:

- 1. NCDEQ Public Water Supply guidelines would be followed.
- 2. The line would be designed and permitted by a qualified engineer.
- 3. The installation would be carried out by a licensed and qualified contractor.
- 4. As-built drawings would be provided to the Town of Spruce Pine.
- 5. The line would need to be a minimum of 6-inches in diameter, for future additional customers and fire protection.
- 6. The Town of Spruce Pine would bear none of the cost of the project, from planning through construction.

Additionally, the Town's policies require that we charge for all taps. We realize the above stipulations would cause this project to be very expensive and that you may desire to go another route. We wish your family success in acquiring water for this property, whether by means of a well or by extending a private line to meet the Town's main line along Highway 226.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE CONTRACT WITH LARRY MCKINNEY FOR VEHICLE CLEANING

NOW COMES the Town Council for the Town of Spruce Pine ("Town"), at a duly called meeting with a quorum established, and hereby adopts this *Resolution Authorizing the Town to Enter into a Service Contract with Larry McKinney for Vehicle Cleaning* ("Resolution").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, in January 2024, the Town instructed the Town Manager to solicit bids for vehicle cleaning services for the Town's vehicle fleet (seventeen (17) vehicles at the time of the bid solicitation) ("Service");

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2024 when the bids were announced, the lowest bidder was Larry McKinney;

WHEREAS, Larry McKinney is currently an elected member of the Town Council and is a "public officer" as that term is defined in N.C.G.S. § 14-234(a1)(1);

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 14-234(d1), the small jurisdiction exception applies in that the population for the Town is less than 20,000 people and the costs for the Service is less than \$60,000 within a 12-month period; and

WHEREAS, during the February 12, 2024 Town meeting, Mr. McKinney recused himself during that portion of the meeting where the Service was discussed and voted upon and Mr. McKinney played no role in making the contract and will have no role in the future administration of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN the following:

- 1. That this Resolution be adopted pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 14-234(d1)(1) in an open and public meeting and recorded in the minutes.
- 2. That the contract for Services be awarded to Larry McKinney pursuant to this Resolution and based on the bid solicitation and responses thereto.
- 3. That the Town Manager be authorized to enter a contract on the Town's behalf with Mr. McKinney for the Service. The contract shall be noted in the Town's audited financial statements and the Town shall post in the Town Hall the information required in N.C.G.S. § 14-234(d1)(4) and shall update the information quarterly.
- 4. The contract shall include a provision that any complaints regarding Mr. McKinney's performance of the Service, if any, shall be provided to the Town Manager who shall provide that information to the Mayor.

Hourly Employee Incentive Program for Achieving and Maintaining Operator in Responsible Charge (ORC) Credentials for Water Distribution, Wastewater Collections, and/or Cross Connection.

For each grade level attained toward ORC in a category (Distribution, Collections, or Cross Connection) an hourly employee will receive a bonus of \$2000. This bonus will be paid in two increments of \$1000. The first will be paid when the State of NC certificate for the grade level is presented. The second increment will follow six months later, provided the employee is still employed by the Town of Spruce Pine. Each bonus increment will be paid as an addition to a regular paycheck, and will be subject to tax and retirement withholding. The employee will be reimbursed and/or receive a bonus up to the certification grade level required to serve as ORC for the Town of Spruce Pine. Certifications levels beyond minimum requirements for Town ORC will not be eligible for reimbursement of class and testing expenses or additional bonus awards.

Once the employee is qualified to serve as ORC for the Town of Spruce Pine in a category, that employee will move to the next higher pay grade on the pay plan in effect. The step on the pay grade will remain unchanged. This will result in an approximate 5% hourly increase. The employee will continue to receive this increased amount as long as their ORC-level certification is maintained. Only one such salary increase will be awarded even if the employee is qualified to serve as ORC in more than one category.

The Town of Spruce Pine will pay for pre-approved training costs, including classes, materials, and travel.

This policy will be retroactive to February 1, 2023 for employees currently employed with the Town of Spruce Pine.



The water plant, pump stations, and both wells operated in full compliance with all State and Federal rules for the month. The Water Plant collected six (6) bacteriological samples from the distribution system and all were clear.

12/06/23- Gerald Glenn installed a VFD on well # 2 to compensate for the reduced flow. Both wells are producing around 140 GPM each. In recent years, both wells combined yielded around 450 GPM. Something has changed.

12/06/23- One of our North Toe River raw water pumps failed. Since this pump had already been rebuilt once in February of 2012, we opted to replace it with a new pump. SW Services has the PO# with a completion date late January 2024.

12/07/23 SW Services came and verified flow on our Summit Avenue water booster pump. They used a portable flow meter since the one at the station is out of service. I will be budgeting for a new flow meter in 2024. The pump is moving 235 GPM to the cemetery tank.

12/11/23- Lightning took out level transmitting equipment at Overlook storage tank. CCU repaired.

12/20/23- Caught and shipped PFAS samples from the water plant per EPA requirements .

12/20/23- State inspection at the water plant. All is well. She will be sending out a full report.

12/23/23 Beaver Creek Reservoir is full and overflowing.
